INTRODUCTION

Haya Water has a requirement to hire Equipment to lift heavy item like pump, blower, pipe, transfer mobile unit & etc. The Fleet management team is responsible to provide this service for all divisions as per requirement in different Sewage Treatment Plants (STP) and pump station (PS).

GENERAL SCOPE

HR division is looking for a reliable contractor to provide smooth Crane and Prime-mover equipment services to attend any call-off across Muscat area.

Scope of Works:

- The contractor should have the capacity to provide 25 Tons, 50 Tons, 70 Tons, 100 Tons, 120 Ton, 130 Ton cranes, 10-ton Hiab, Wheel Loader (Shovel), Tipper 50 Tons and & 4x4 Prime movers to meet our requirement
- 2. The contractor is responsible to provide operators & drivers with all HSE requirements.
- 3. The contractor is responsible to ensure on time arrival to the location, within 4 hours, after receiving the call from Haya Water Logistics management team.
- The contractor is responsible to provide required equipment (Prime mover & cranes) in maintained and good condition with valid Test certificate and inspection certificate for lifting equipment from third party.
- The contractor is responsible to provide required equipment in different destinations either in the STP or pumping stations within Muscat, as provided in the call by Haya Water Logistics management team
- 6. The contractor should get the delivery note signed by Haya Water staff with the name and staff number on site then submit it along with the invoice to Logistics Management Team.
- 7. The contractor is responsible to ensure all required lifting equipment are available with correct slings and other crane tools.
- 8. The contractor is responsible to report the journey management details to Haya Water Logistics management team on every request for equipment.
- 9. The Contractor may be requested to provide more than one type of equipment per day based on Logistics management requests.
